To make your own version of Stormy Stars to go with your new favorite book, *The Promise Girls*, you will need to choose three similar light greens, two dark blues, and a white. We can't wait to see how your Stormy Stars quilt comes to life.

Fabric Requirements

Based on 40" of usable fabric with few cutting errors.

Bright Accent (Dark W)		½ yard
Multi Colored Focus (Dark V)		¾ yard
Green X		⅓ yard
Green Y		½ yard
Green Z		¼ yard

Unit Summary

Note: That Accent Diamond E and F are mirror images of each other. Use care when constructing them.



Focus Diamond (D)

Dark V, Green Y, and White 3"x 6" finished (3½"x 6½" unfinished) Make 4



Accent Diamond (E)*

Dark W, Green Y, and White 3"x 6" finished (3½"x 6½" unfinished) Make 4



Accent Diamond (F)*

Dark W, Green Y, and White 3"x 6" finished (3½"x 6½" unfinished) Make 4



Border V Block (H)*

Dark V and White 3"x 3" finished (3 1/2" x 3 1/2" unfinished) Make 8



Diamond Square (A)

Dark W and Green X 3"x 3" finished (3½"x 3½" unfinished) Make 1



Diamond Square (B)

Dark V, Green Y, and White 3"x 3" finished (3½"x 3½" unfinished) Make 4



Diamond Square (C)

White, Dark V, and Dark W 3"x 3" finished (3½"x 3½" unfinished) Make 4



Diamond Square (G)

Green X, Green Y, Green Z, Dark V, and Dark W 6"x 6" finished (6\%"x 6\%" unfinished)

Make 4


Follow the piecing order on the paper foundations to piece your units. The above diagrams are labeled to correspond to the paper foundations, position your fabrics on the corresponding number on the foundation to ensure that you get your fabrics in the correct positions. Also, make sure you print using "actual size" rather than 100% or "fit to page". If you do not print using Actual Size the foundations will not be the correct size. For the borders cut 4 squares $3\frac{1}{2}$ "x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " for the corners and 4 rectangles $3\frac{1}{2}$ "x $15\frac{1}{2}$ " for the sides.







